Multi-tenant production system built on 100+ MCP tools, agents-as-employees patterns with their own inboxes and supervised autonomy, and model-agnostic AI tooling across Mastra and Vercel AI Gateway. An open MCP server with OAuth lets customers run their fleet from any AI client (Claude Desktop, ChatGPT, Cursor) using their own credentials with a full audit trail.

Designed and built multiple custom modules extending Fiserv's core account processing platform - eAlerts (account, credit-card, and transaction notifications with full enrollment management), a secure messaging system between credit-union staff and members, a rates management module for streamlined approval and administration, and account wizard customisations across multiple credit unions.

- Mortgage LOS - Core Integration (2013–2014): customized Encompass Mortgage LOS to integrate with the DNA core, enabling end-to-end loan origination without leaving the platform.
- Teller Next Generation (2012–2014): re-platformed core credit-union teller system on modern .NET with a flexible, maintainable design.
- Back Office Manager - Commercial DDA / Account Analysis (2011–2012): built commercial accounts and cash-management services on top of the existing DataSafe system.
- Master Person 4 (2009–2011): architectural overhaul of the CU Core application, re-modelling account flow as person-centric.
- Cash Dispenser / Recycler (2008–2009): teller-facing UI plus admin application for setup, configuration, and reporting on Cash/Coin Devices.
- Virtuoso - Online Banking (2007–2008): online banking application with standard and advanced account-management features.
- FQSuiteCase (2006–2007): three-module travel solution (BackOffice, Online, Sub-Agent) covering booking, itinerary management, and reporting for travel companies.
